USE AND DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION:

The St. Catharines Golf & Country Club Limited (“the Club”) collects personal information as detailed on the membership application form for the following purposes:

- To determine eligibility for different classes of membership
- To set up and manage membership files upon acceptance
- To assess a potential member’s credit worthiness
- After acceptance, to mail monthly statements of account, newsletters and annual reports
- To communicate with a member regarding the collection of an account
- To notify of upcoming meetings and Club events
- To determine members’ areas of interest for possible service on Committees or for contract work opportunities around the Club
- To enable other members to contact you to arrange a mutual activity such as a curling game

DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION:

I understand that the Club may disclose personal information about its members as follows:

- Name, photo, phone numbers, email address, addresses, year of joining and access number on the Club's website for use by other members and staff
- Member Profile information will be shared with the Pro Shop for their use in billing golf carts, greens fees, and merchandise as well as for verifying allowable tee off times

Furthermore, certain outside service providers, including the Club’s computer hardware and software providers, accountants and legal counsel, may have access to personal information although these providers are also subject to the federal legislation governing the protection of personal information. Under no circumstances does the Club sell or market its membership list to third parties.

WITHDRAWAL OF CONSENT:

Subject to legal and contractual requirements, a member may refuse or withdraw consent at any time by giving the Club reasonable notice, provided the consent does not relate to certain information required for credit collection.

ACCURACY OF INFORMATION:

The Club will endeavour to maintain the accuracy of all information kept and that it is the member’s responsibility to inform the Club promptly of any change in that information. If a member believes that personal, factual information in the Club’s records may be inaccurate, that member may request access to the information by contacting our Privacy Officer, Lisa Hunt, at (905) 682-8681 x 226 and request appropriate amendments.
